Quick Start Guide

Installation & Basic Configuration

Congratulations on purchasing Chelsio's Unified Storage Server (USS), a complete SAN + NAS software solution. This quick start guide describes the steps to install and complete the basic configuration of the product.

This document is in addition to the user's guide, which covers administration of USS.

Conventions Used

Special attention should be given to the following symbols for completing the installation successfully:



Action: Instruction to be followed in order to ensure proper installation of the product.



Result: Denotes the result to be expected after following an Action.



Note: Additional information provided to facilitate installation of the product or better understanding of the guide.

Step 1

Verify the Packing List of Items

Check that the following items have been included with your software:

1. One *Unified Storage Server* installation CD or ISO image
2. One *Unified Storage Server Quick Start Guide* (this document)
3. One *Unified Storage Server User's Guide*
4. One *Unified Storage Server README*
5. One *Unified Storage Server Release Notes*

The USS CD ISO image and related documents can also be downloaded from Chelsio. If this is the case, once the image has been received, burn the ISO image to a CD before proceeding.

Missing items: If any of these items are missing or need replacement, please contact Chelsio at support@chelsio.com.

Step 2

Verify the System Requirements

The system used for this product must meet the following minimum system requirements:

Processor	1 dual core processor, AMD Opteron / Intel EM64T Xeon
Memory	4GB RAM or more recommended
Ethernet NIC	Chelsio T4/T3 adapter
Storage	Any of FC, SAS, SATA, SSD, RAID
OS Drive	4GB disk
CD Drive	Only for the installation of USS



The OS drive can be a SATA-DOM, Software RAID, USB flash drive, IDE, SATA, or SAS drive. The recommended size of the drive is 4GB or more.


Step 3

Boot from the USS CD

The Chelsio USS CD is a complete bootable Operating System which contains the storage software and documentation. The USS CD must be booted to proceed with the installation.



Power on the system with the USS CD in the CD/DVD drive.



Booting from CD/DVD drive



The system BIOS must be set to boot from the CD/DVD drive before other devices. Most systems have their default configuration set this way so unless the boot order has been altered, no action is necessary.



The system will then show a Unified Storage Server boot screen with a progress bar.

Step 4(a)

Installing USS

The USS boot screen transitions to the Chelsio Unified Storage Installer Wizard. This wizard will walk you through the steps necessary to install the software.



Please read the Help section on the right side of the Wizard for every screen carefully before selecting any option.

If you are looking to upgrade your existing USS Appliance, please refer to **Step 4(b)**.



Screen 1: Choose the Installation type

The first screen of the wizard will ask for the installation type. Enter 1 for a new installation.

Certain disks may be skipped because of any of the following reasons: it is too small in size (a minimum of 4GB is required), or it is a SAN LUN, or it is currently managed with volume management.

When the system restarts, the USS boot screen with the progress bar will appear. After it finishes, the welcome screen will appear. Skip to Step 5 now.

If you are already running the latest version of USS, you can skip this step. If you're planning to upgrade USS from 2.2.0 version, please contact Chelsio support team for a 3.0.0 compatible license.

In case of HA, please ensure that no I/O operation is running on the node being upgraded, since **Live Upgrade** is not supported.


When the system starts to boot back up, the USS boot screen with the progress bar will appear. After it finishes, the welcome screen will appear.

System Setup Wizard


